- New partnership allows Nationwide E&S insureds to leverage Samsara's leading video telematics solutions in their operations at a subsidized cost

[According to Samsara](#), more than half of its dash cam customers have used footage to exonerate drivers in the past year – saving \$5,000 to \$25,000 on average, with some customers saving over \$100,000 a year. Additionally, 15% of Samsara dash cam customers have reported reduced insurance premiums after successfully implementing and managing the Samsara telematics program.

- Real-time GPS fleet tracking and vehicle diagnostics
- Mobile Driver App with Electronic Logging Device (ELD) data, routing and messaging
- Customized monthly and quarterly safety reporting to track and support safety initiatives
